Open the database (in italics). Search for the term(s) in bold print. Find the answer(s) to the question(s) using that database.

1) Click on the icon for *CultureGrams*. Click on World Edition. Click on the arrow next to Select a Region or Country. Scroll down to **Afghanistan** in the Country list, and select it. How many languages are spoken in this country? (Look under “Did You Know?”.)

2) Click on the icon for *Gale eBooks*. Search for **Jonestown Massacre**. Open the article about the massacre from *Dictionary of American History*.

a) What is the name of the author of this article?

b) Of the 913 members of the Peoples Temple cult who died at Jonestown, how many of them were children? (Answer is near the beginning of the article.)

c) What did the followers of Jim Jones drink that caused their deaths in this mass suicide? (Answer is near the end of the article.)

3) Click on the icon for *CQ Researcher*. Use the “Search within *CQ Researcher*” search box to search for an article called “**Plastic Pollution**.” There are two articles with that same title—open the most recent one of the two by clicking on the title.

a) What is the online pub date of this article (including month and day)?

b) Who wrote this article?

4) Click on the icon for *Teen Health and Wellness*. Search for **ecoanxiety**. Open the article called “Ecoanxiety.” **Open the section** of the article called **Myths and Facts About** (article sections are listed on the left). What is the first myth?

5) Click on the icon for *Issues & Controversies*. Search for **vaping** (TYPE this word into the search box then hit Enter—do NOT select from the drop-down box). Open the article called “By the Numbers: Vaping and E-Cigarettes.”

a) What is the date of the article in which the information in this chart originally appeared?

b) The third line of the chart gives the estimated annual sales of e-cigarettes in the United States in 2019. What is that amount?

6) Click on the icon for *American History*. Search for **great molasses spill**. Open the article.

a) What was the name of the harbor in which this flood of 2.3 million gallons of molasses occurred? (The answer is in the second sentence of the article.)

b) What is the name of one of the authors who wrote this article? (Look in the Record Information box to the right.)

7) Click on the icon for *Britannica School*. Search for **Kodiak bear**. Open the article. Kodiak bears can be found on an island off the coast of what state?

8) Click on the icon for *World Geography & Culture Online*. Under Select a Country, select **Ukraine**. Write the description for Area Comparison (under At-A-Glance).

9) Click on the icon for *ProQuest Central Student*. Search for **coronavirus**. How many total results are there?

10) You choose the database for this question—in what year did **George Washington** (president) die, and in which database did you find that answer?
