Open the database (in italics). Search for the term(s) in bold print. Find the answer(s) to the question(s) using that database.

1) Click on the icon for *CultureGrams*. Click on World Edition. Click on the arrow next to Select a Region or Country. Scroll down to **China** in the Country list, and select it. Even though China is slightly smaller than the United States, how many times more inhabitants does it have? (Look under “Did You Know?”.)

2) Click on the icon for *Gale eBooks*. Search for **Golden Gate Bridge**. There are two articles about the bridge--open the one from *St. James Encyclopedia of Popular Culture*.

a) What is the name of the author of this article?

b) In what year was this bridge completed?

c) How many feet is this bridge able to sway in high winds?

3) Click on the icon for *CQ Researcher*. Use the “Search within *CQ Researcher*” search box to search for an article called “**K-Pop**.” Open the article.

a) What is the online pub date of this article (including month and day)?

b) Who wrote this article?

4) Click on the icon for *Teen Health and Wellness*. Search for **concussions**. Open the article called “Concussions.” **Open the section** of the article called **Myths and Facts About** (article sections are listed on the left). What is the first myth?

5) Click on the icon for *Issues & Controversies*. Search for **junk food** (TYPE this word into the search box then hit Enter—**do NOT select from the drop-down box**). Scroll down and open the article called “By the Numbers: Junk Food in Schools.”

a) What is the date of the article in which the information in this chart originally appeared?

b) The fourth line of the chart gives the percentage of American children who were obese in 2018. What is that percentage?

6) Click on the icon for *American History*. Search for **Peshtigo fire**. Open the article.

a) How many **acres** did this fire in Wisconsin destroy?

b) What is the name of the author who wrote this article? (Look in the Record Information box to the right.)

7) Click on the icon for *Britannica School*. Search for **giant panda**. Open the article. How many pandas are thought to remain in the wild?

8) Click on the icon for *World Geography & Culture Online*. Under Select a Country, select **Germany**. Write the description for Area Comparison (under At-A-Glance).

9) Click on the icon for *ProQuest Central Student*. Search for **Afghanistan**. How many total results are there?

10) Click on the icon for *Salem Online*. Search for **Great London Smog**. Open the article called “1952: The Great London Smog.” How many people died as a result of this smog? (Answer is on the Result line.)

11) Click on *Ferguson’s Career Guidance Center*. Search for **cardiologists**. Open the article. What is the median salary of a cardiologist?
