*At her new boarding school, Lainey Young has visions that confirm she is one of the Sententia, a society for the psychically gifted, but she and crush Carter Penrose soon learn that the extent of her powers may be putting her danger.*

**Draw the Dark**

*Seventeen-year-old Christian is a painter who is developing some disturbing talents. He can paint others' thoughts and memories, perhaps even influencing their actions. He is also having some vivid dreams in which he inhabits the body of a child in the 1940s, watching as a town business leader uses German POWs as laborers. Christian awakes from one of these fugues to find himself blamed for painting swastikas on a barn, a terrible event that results in two fortuitous meetings: a dying old man in a nursing home with a connection to Christian's dreams and a friendly psychiatrist who becomes his chief confidant.*

**Drain You**

*Even after Quinn Lacey learns that the coast of Southern California is crawling with vampires, she still tries to keep her job at the video store, convince her parents that she is eating well, and rescue her best friend from a fate worse than death.*

**Struck**

*After a major earthquake devastates Los Angeles, seventeen-year-old Mia wants only to take care of her younger brother and traumatized mother. Two fanatical doomsday cults, however, vie for her powers which are drawn from the multiple lightning strikes she has experienced.*

**The Diviners (and sequel)**

*Seventeen-year-old Evie O'Neill is thrilled when she is exiled from small-town Ohio to New York City in 1926, even when a rash of occult-based murders thrusts Evie and her uncle, curator of The Museum of American Folklore, Superstition, and the Occult, into the thick of the investigation.*

**A Great and Terrible Beauty (and sequels)**

*1<sup>st</sup> book in the Gemma Doyle series. After the suspicious death of her mother in 1895, sixteen-year-old Gemma returns to England, after many years in India, to attend a finishing school where she becomes aware of her magical powers and ability to see into the spirit world.*

**Night Sky**

*Sixteen-year-old Skylar Reid joins her best friend Cal, Dana, a girl with supernatural abilities, and Dana's friend Milo on a quest to rescue young Sasha from the Organization that kidnapped her because, according to Dana, Sky and Sasha both have special abilities, too.*

**Wolf Mark**

*When Lucas King's covert-ops father is kidnapped and his best friend Meena is put in danger, Luke's only chance to save them--a skin that will let him walk as a wolf--is hidden away in an abandoned mansion guarded by monsters.*

**The Presence: A Ghost Story**

*While visiting her grandmother in California, seventeen-year-old Catherine comes in contact with a mysterious stranger who says he can help her contact a friend who died in a car crash for which Catherine feels responsible.*

**Glass Houses (and sequels)**

*1<sup>st</sup> book in the Morganville Vampires series. Welcome to Morganville, Texas--just don't stay out after dark. College freshman Claire Danvers has had enough of her nightmarish dorm situation, where the popular girls never let her forget just where she ranks in the school's social scene: somewhere less than zero. When Claire heads off-campus, the imposing old house where she finds a room may not be much better. Her new roommates don't show many signs of life. But they'll have Claire's back when the town's deepest secrets come crawling out, hungry for fresh blood.*

**Clockwork Angel (and sequels)**

*1<sup>st</sup> book in Infernal Devices series. When sixteen-year-old orphan Tessa Fell's older brother suddenly vanishes, her search for him leads her into Victorian-era London's dangerous supernatural underworld. When she discovers that she herself is a Downworlder, she must learn to trust the demon-killing Shadowhunters if she ever wants to learn to control her powers and find her brother.*

**Lady Midnight (and sequel)**

*1<sup>st</sup> book in Dark Artifices series. Shadowhunter Emma Carstairs and her parabatai Julian Blackthorn race to stop a demonic plot that threatens Los Angeles*

**Scintillate (and sequel)**

*Cora Sandoval's mother disappeared when she was five and they were living in Ireland. Since then, her dad has been more than overprotective, and Cora is beginning to chafe under his confines. But even more troubling is the colorful light she suddenly sees around people. Everyone, that is, except herself—she glows a brilliant, sparkling silver. Could her newfound powers change mankind forever—and possibly end her life?*

**Texas Gothic**

*Seventeen-year-old Amy Goodnight has long been the one who makes her family of witches seem somewhat normal to others, but while spending a summer with her sister caring for their aunt's farm, Amy becomes the center of weirdness when she becomes tied to a powerful ghost.*

**Switch**

A modern-day retelling of Hans Christian Andersen's "Snow Queen."*

**Low Red Moon**

*Seventeen-year-old Avery can remember nothing to explain her parents' violent death in the woods where they live, but after meeting Ben, a mysterious new neighbor, she begins to believe some of the stories she has heard about creatures of the forest.*

**Waves**

*While spending the summer with the family away from his comatose sister, Hal discovers their bond is stronger than he thought as her visions begin to fill his head and the truth surrounding her accident becomes clearer with every passing day.*

**Unbreakable**

*Seventeen-year-old Kennedy Waters discovers she is a member of an ancient secret society formed to protect the world from a powerful demon determined to find a way out of his dimension and into ours. She joins the Legion on a mission to find a weapon that can defeat the demon.*

**Fateful**

*When seventeen-year-old Tess Davies, a ladies' maid, meets handsome Alec Marlow aboard the RMS Titanic, she quickly becomes entangled in the dark secrets of his past, but her growing love puts her in mortal peril even before fate steps in.*

**Half Bad (and sequel)**

*In modern-day England, where witches live alongside humans, Nathan, son of a White witch and the most powerful Black witch, must escape captivity before his seventeenth birthday and receive the gifts that will determine his future.*

**Revel**

*Looking for her grandmother, seventeen-year-old Delia goes to an isolated island in Maine and discovers a frightening and supernatural world where ancient Greek symbols adorn the buildings and secret ceremonies take place on the beach at night.*

**Unearthly (and sequels)**

*1<sup>st</sup> book in Unearthly series. Sixteen-year-old Clara Gardner's purpose as an angel-blood begins to manifest itself, forcing her family to pull up stakes and move to Jackson, Wyoming, where she learns that danger and heartbreak come with her powers.*

**Haunting Violet**

*Fifteen-year-old Izzy, who comes from a long line of monster hunters, investigates a series of hauntings at her new high school.*

**Henderson, Jason**                      **Vampire Rising**

*At a boarding school in Switzerland, Alex Van Helsing learns that vampires are real, that he has a natural ability to sense them, and that an agency called the Polidorium has been helping his family fight them since 1821.*

**Hieber, Leanna Renee**                      **Darker Still** (and sequel)

*1<sup>st</sup> in Magic Most Foul series. While Jonathan's soul is trapped in a painting by dark magic, his possessed body commits unspeakable crimes in the slums of 1882 New York City. Luring Natalie Stewart into the painting is the only way his damaged soul can be freed.*

**Hocking, Amanda**                      **Switched** (and sequels)

*1<sup>st</sup> book in Trylle series. When Wendy Everly was six years old, her mother was convinced she was a monster and tried to kill her. Eleven years later Wendy learns that her mother was right and that she is actually a changeling troll who, at the age of seventeen, must be returned to her rightful home*

**Hodkin, Michelle**                      **The Unbecoming of Mara Dyer** (and sequels)

*1<sup>st</sup> book in Mara Dyer series. Seventeen-year-old Mara cannot remember the accident that took the lives of three of her friends, but, after moving from Rhode Island to Florida, finding love with Noah, and more deaths, she realizes that uncovering something buried in her memory might save her family and her future.*

**Holder, Nancy**                      **Crusade**

*An international team of six teenaged vampire hunters, trained in Salamanca, Spain, goes to New Orleans seeking to rescue team-member Jenn's younger sister as the vampires escalate their efforts to take over the Earth.*

**Hunt, Leo**                      **13 Days of Midnight**

*When his estranged father dies, sixteen-year-old Luke inherits eight spirits who want revenge for their enslavement. With Halloween fast approaching, he has only thirteen days to give them their eternal rest or he may join their ghostly ranks.*

**Jackson, Corrine**                      **Touched** (and sequels)

*1<sup>st</sup> book in Sense Thieves series. Possessing powers that enable her to heal others while taking their injuries into herself, Remy O'Malley is sent to live with her estranged father and pursues a forbidden relationship with Asher Blackwell, who sacrificed his senses to become immortal.*

**Johnson, Maureen**                      **The Name of the Star** (and sequels)

*1<sup>st</sup> book in Shades of London series. Rory, of Boueuxlieu, Louisiana, is spending a year at a London boarding school when she witnesses a murder by a Jack the Ripper copycat and becomes involved with the very unusual investigation.*

**Jones, Carrie**                      **Need** (and sequels)

*1<sup>st</sup> book in the Need series. Depressed after the death of her stepfather, high school junior Zara goes to live with her grandmother in a small Maine town, where new friends tell Zara the strange man she keeps seeing may be a pixie king and that only "were" creatures can stop him from taking souls.*

**King, Stephen**                      **Bag of Bones**

*Plagued by vivid nightmares of the summer house he had shared with his late wife, grieving widower Mike Noonan returns to his former Maine getaway only to find a town in the grip of a ruthless millionaire and tormented by a series of ghostly visitations.*

**King, Stephen**                      **The Dead Zone**

*After four and a half years in a coma, Johnny Smith awakens with knowledge of the death zone and an ability to see the future, a horrible power that he does not want and cannot escape.*

*The story of a convicted killer on death row and one of the prison guards assigned there.*

**The Gunslinger (and sequels)**

*1<sup>st</sup> book in Dark Tower series. Roland, the world's last gunslinger, tracks an enigmatic Man in Black toward a forbidding dark tower, fighting forces both mortal and other-worldly on his quest.*

*Ralph Roberts, a widower suffering from insomnia, begins to experience strange visual phenomena and is unable to believe that they are merely hallucinations.*

**From the Corner of His Eye**

*Bartholomew Lampion, born under miraculous yet tragic circumstances, has the most unusual and mesmerizing eyes ever seen. As he grows, he begins to exhibit abilities that defy physics. Angel, born in another city at the same time as Bartholomew, is also a miracle child; as she grows, she demonstrates the ability to see the world as it really exists. At the time of their births, ruthless and cunning Junior dreams that someone named Bartholomew will lead to his downfall. *Discovering a medieval book and a cache of letters, a motherless American girl becomes the latest in a series of historians, including her late father, who investigate the possible surviving legacy of Vlad the Impaler.*

**Langston, Elizabeth**

**I Wish**

*While at a flea market, Lacey Linden finds a music box that contains a genie that offers to grant her one wish a day for a month.*

**Larbalestier, Justine**

**Liar**

*Compulsive liar Micah promises to tell the truth after revealing that her boyfriend has been murdered.*

**Laurie, Victoria**

**When**

*Sixteen-year-old Maddie Flynn cannot help but see the death date of everyone she meets or sees in a photograph or online, and her alcoholic mother exploits this by having her do readings for money—but when Maddie predicts the death of a young boy, she becomes the center of an FBI investigation.*

**Lewis, Sylvia**

**Beautiful Decay**

*Possessing the ability to cause everything she touches to rot away, Ellie avoids others until a newcomer reveals himself to be a death-controlling necromancer with whom Ellie battles a zombie and a group of supernatural evildoers.*

**Linko, Gina**

**Indigo**

*Seventeen-year-old Corrine's ability to read people's physio-electricity seems to have brought about her sister's death, but a new friend, Rennick, thinks it might actually be a sixth sense that can be controlled.*

**Maggi, Nicole**

**Winter Falls (and sequels)**

*1<sup>st</sup> book in Twin Willows series. When a new family moves into town, sixteen-year-old Alessia learns that she is a member of the Benandanti, a cult of warriors capable of transforming into animals.*

**Mather, Adriana**

**How to Hang a Witch**

*Follows fifteen-year-old Samantha Mather who has moved to Salem with her stepmother 300 years after her family hanged witches there to find she is ostracized by the witch descendants at school as she unravels the lost secrets of the hangings and her family. The author is a descendant of Cotton Mather, one of the men responsible for the Salem witch trials.*

**McConnel, Jen**                      **Daughter of Chaos**

*There comes a time in every witch's life when she must choose her path. Darlena's friends have already chosen, so why is it so hard for her to make up her mind? Now, Darlena is out of time. Under pressure from Hecate, the Queen of all witches, Darlena makes a rash decision to choose Red magic, a path no witch in her right mind would dare take. As a Red witch, she will be responsible for chaos and mayhem, drawing her deep into darkness. Will the power of Red magic prove too much for Darlena, or will she learn to control it before it's too late?*

**McCoy, Mary**                      **Camp So-and-So**

*The 25 campers who arrive at Camp So -and -So expect hiking, rowing, and other normal camp activities, but they soon become involved in increasingly weird and potentially dangerous circumstances. The girls, divided into five cabins, must fend for themselves and navigate through a tangled thicket of clues and deadly traps. There is a psychotic murderer to be eluded, a heroic quest to be pursued, the intoxicating promise of true love, and dark forces at work that can split souls.*

**McEntire, Myra**                      **Hourglass (and sequels)**

*1<sup>st</sup> book in Hourglass series. Seventeen-year-old Emerson uses her power to manipulate time to help Michael, a consultant hired by her brother, to prevent a murder that happened six months ago while simultaneously navigating their undeniable attraction to one another.*

**McKissack, Jennifer**                      **Sanctuary**

*After the sudden death of her aunt, Cecilia Cross is forced to return to the old mansion on a remote island off the coast of Maine, ironically named Sanctuary, the place where her father and sister died and from which her mother was committed to an insane asylum soon after--and it is also a place of dark secrets--haunted by the ghosts of its original owners and inhabited by her vicious uncle.*

**McMann, Lisa**                      **Crash (and sequels)**

*1<sup>st</sup> book in Visions series. Sixteen-year-old Jules, whose family owns an Italian restaurant and has a history of mental illness, starts seeing a recurring vision about a rival restaurant, a truck crash, and forbidden love.*

**McMann, Lisa**                      **Cryer's Cross**
